The Access to Insight programme currently offers two types of funding:

- The **Basic Research Grant** which supports research projects focusing on basic and translational research in haemostasis
- The Clinical Research Grant which supports innovative haemostatic research on non-interventional observational studies focusing on patient outcomes, quality of life and social impact

Basic Research Grant

- up to €70,000
- 12–18 month period
- Focus: Basic science or translational research relevant to the understanding of the pathophysiology and treatment of haemostatic disorders

Clinical Research Grant

- up to €70,000
- 12 month period
- Focus: Innovative haemostatic research in rare bleeding disorders on noninterventional observational studies, focusing on patient outcomes, quality of life and social impact
